

All Texas school districts and charter schools are entitled to receive payments from the Available School Fund (ASF) for each eligible student enrolled. ASF payments are referred to as “per capita” payments. The General Appropriations Act contains an estimate of the amount to be paid to school districts and charter schools for the 2024-25 school year.
